# Church of Our Lady of Good Counsel - St. Thomas More February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time focus on the importance of following God's commandments for daily living. The challenge, of course, lies in the fact that God's laws are demanding, and we can freely discard this divine charge. Last Sunday we heard the beginning of the sermon where Jesus developed metaphors for discipleship (salt and light). In today's Gospel reading, we hear a remarkable range of subjects in this sermon (for example, anger, retaliation, adultery, and divorce). For Matthew, Jesus' Sermon on the Mount is the new interpretation of the Mosaic law that all believers in his community (predominantly Jewish Christians) must now follow.

Two sayings in Jesus' Sermon on the Mount best summarize the main point of this extended discourse. The first is the opening statement heard in today's reading: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have not come to abolish but to fulfill" (5:17). The second saying: "Do to others whatever you would have them do to you. This is the law and the prophets" (7:12). With the Sermon on the Mount, Matthew presents Jesus as fulfilling the law, not replacing it. In this way, Jesus as the "new Moses" is the fundamental portrait of Christ in the Gospel of Matthew. The Matthean Jesus, and the Jewish Christians of Matthew's community, still followed the fundamental tenets of the law and the prophets. But while the Mosaic law remained a requirement ("You have heard that it was said..."), it was now to be informed and supplemented with Jesus' golden rule of benevolence toward others ("But I say to you...").
