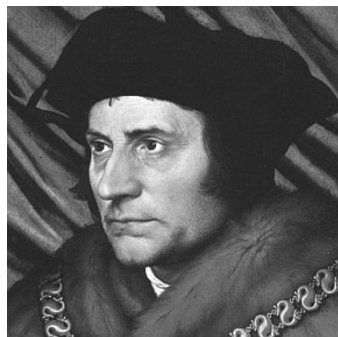

Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Theme/Call To Worship

The readings for the Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time remind us of the Jewish roots of our Christian identity, the lens through which Jesus taught about Himself and the kingdom of God.

Introduction To The Word

Deuteronomy 6:2-6: The first reading presents Israel's *Shema*: "Hear, O Israel!" Moses taught the Israelites that the continual focus on this simple prayer would be their best assurance to keep all the statutes required of them, as they transitioned from wandering in the desert to a future of stability, growth, and prosperity in the Promised Land.

Hebrews 7:23-28: The second reading from the Letter to the Hebrews associates the priesthood of Jesus with the Levitical priesthood, and it offers us a deeper understanding of how Jesus "has been made perfect forever."

Mark 12:28b-34: In today's reading an unnamed scribe took his turn with a question for Jesus, "Which is the first of all the commandments?" A potentially tricky question, since Israel had over six hundred written commandments and countless oral commandments. Although it is not surprising that Jesus begins with the *Shema*, what may have surprised and delighted the scribe was Jesus' addition of a second commandment, to love neighbor as self. Two commandments which lay at the heart of Jesus' teachings.
