Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Theme/Call To Worship

The readings for today's liturgy invite the gathered assembly to take a hard look at sin, to call it by name and to take responsibility for it.

Introduction To The Word

Genesis 3:9-15: Today's first reading represents the ongoing struggle between good and evil, which is the human experience. The story of the fall returns us to the fact that human beings have been created as free agents by God capable of rejecting God's goodness in favor of their own willful and proud desires. But when free human choices cause things to go awry, God does not turn away, leaving them to their own designs, as the ancient Yahwistic author points out, God comes searching, "Where are you?"

2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1: By faith, Paul could be certain that human existence is not a hapless series of coincidences but a life ordered to the benefit of humanity by God.

Mark 3:20-35: In this reading, Jesus appealed to both those who attacked his goodness and those who thought Jesus had lost his mind. Jesus explained to the crowd that those who would associate with him would not be in collusion with Satan or incurring sin. Rather, those who accepted him in truth would come to know the very will of God through his words and works.
