The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

Theme/Call To Worship

The solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist celebrates John's fidelity to his call and place in God's plan for our salvation. In this way, John serves as a model of humility for us.

Introduction To The Word

Is 49:1-6: The first reading is from the prophet Isaiah who proclaimed to the captive Israelites God's plan to once again unite the divided kingdom, and God's plan to extend his salvation to all nations.

Acts 13:22-26: In the second reading from Acts of the Apostles, Paul attempts to place both Jesus and John within God's plan of salvation for Israel. Rooted in the promises God made to Israel, Paul testified that John was faithful to his call to be the herald of the coming Messiah.

Lk 1:57-66, 80: Embedded within this narration, Luke provides a parallel presentation of the angel Gabriel announcing the birth of John to his father, Zechariah, and the birth of Jesus to his mother, Mary. Like the prophet Isaiah centuries earlier, both Jesus and John were known and named by God from their mothers' wombs, pointing to their central roles in salvation history. In today's Gospel reading we hear not only about John, but also about his mother Elizabeth and his father Zechariah. The birth of John also brought about the liberation of Zechariah. Rendered mute by the angel Gabriel at the annunciation for questioning God, Zechariah received his voice again after he insisted on naming his newborn son John. In naming his son, Zechariah demonstrated his repentance and obedience to God.
